Approach

Client: Adam Cook

Expert Welding and Fabrication: Steel-formed arched hood, custom-welded barbecue and extended surfaces, and custom steel grill tools.

One-of-a-kind: All steel fabrication that was hand-built and welded with forged steel parts.

Installation and grill tests: Our team built two barbecues for Adam to provide a super-wide grilling bed for separate food types. The drop-down front face allows access to the coal bed and eases cleaning. Extended tray surfaces offer ample space for prep and serving needs. The testing, well, the food was *delish*!

RESULTS

We love to help individuals realize their product ideas. Adam Cook and the Past Lives team collaborated on the design and development of a wide-deck barbecue with a removable arched lid. We drew on our expertise in steel fabrication and assembly to create two standing height, mobile barbecues for Adam's backyard meals.

Once Adam had approved our design and a quarter-scale model, we began fabrication working out the details for a hinged hood and front access to the coal bed. We added outboard surfaces and hanging hooks for our custom fabricated steel grilling tools.
